

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

DR. ESTHELLA SANGO Z. BAKER FOUNDATION

WE, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a Not-For-Profit, Corporation, pursuant to the Liberian Codes of Law Revised Volume II, Title Five (5), Association, do hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge and file into the Office of the Minister of Foreign Affairs, this Instrument for the purposes as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Organization (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") shall be known as: DR. ESTHELLA SANGO Z. BAKER FOUNDATION.

The general nature purpose, aims and objectives for which the corporation is established are follows but not limited to the followings:

1. To engage in vocation skills development training programs in the area of carpentry, masonry, baking tie & dye tailoring soap-making and cooking, security, self-awareness within the Republic of Liberia.
2. To build clinic that will cater to the health condition of the people of Grand Bassa County and other parts of Liberia.
3. To build orphanage home that all seek the welfare of children that lost their parents in the following condition Ebola, child birth, war, accident, disaster.
4. To create opportunity for adolescent girls and empowering them to become good future leaders in the society
5. To invest and empower adolescent girls age (10-20) to take active role in their community
6. To build adolescent girls self-esteem and to achieve their aspiration unfettered and unhindered
7. To teach adolescent girls leadership skills and self-esteem skills up-to-date
8. To engage in and carryout community short term and sustainable agriculture projects within the communities
9. Planning and executions of community capacity Building events where the youth can share knowledge and solicit founding for sustaining the organization
10. To engage in and carryout HIV/AIDS awareness/education and other transmitted infections (STIS) within the Republic of Liberia.
11. To engage in education programs sanitation programs counseling through psychosocial rehabilitation, domestic violence community development projects, and medical assistance.
12. To provide basic literacy, community development/sanitation management/activities on sanitation/health community/used of drugs/training advocacy counseling session and support group of transformation on sanitation
13. To create clean and health environment for Liberia and community build their self-esteem and confidence through community programs and livelihood skills training for empowerment, stability and sustainability in their communities
14. To build and establish schools such as pre-schools, primary schools, secondary schools, technical schools, computer schools, vocational schools, adult literacy schools and skill training centers, especially women and children in schools
15. To build libraries, toilets, hand pumps (wells) and additional classrooms, to existing schools where some classes are overcrowded and to promote hygiene, health education and sanitation in schools, communities, towns and villages throughout Liberia
16. To promote sexual reproductive health information and services among adolescent boys and girls in schools, communities, towns and villages;

17. To promote women and youth through skill training, capacity building, micro credit, small business, handicraft, petty trade, food trade, food processing, etc.);
18. To assist and lobby for assistance for both boys and girls who are living under very difficult conditions such as HIV/AIDS Orphans, children of single parents who other parents died from child birth, accident, war, disaster etc.
19. To create clean and health environment for Liberia and community build their self-esteem and confidence through community programs and livelihood skills training for empowerment, stability and sustainability in their communities.
20. To engage in sporting activities, training of students for recreation and fund-raising purposes
21. To provide services and development/recreational programs for the youth, elderly, women, men and children of the community.
22. To engage in charitable, humanitarian and relief activities for the poor and distressed, as well as the marginalized and vulnerable groups in the community.
23. To Cooperate and partnership with other NGOs, CBOs, cooperative relevant government institutions, and the international community in furtherance to attain the objectives
24. To engage in any lawful act or activities for which Non-For-Profit Corporation may now or hereafter be organized under the New Association law of the Republic of Liberia.

ARTICLE II:

The Head Office of the Corporation shall be located in New Buchanan, Buchanan City Grand Bassa County County, Republic of Liberia, west Africa and its shall establish local offices elsewhere in other part of the County as may be determined by its Board of Directors. The Registered Agent is: Dr. Esthella Sango Z. Baker the same address with Cell#0776584189.

ARTICLE III:

The Corporation is an entity as defined by Part II of the Association Law of Liberia and same being charitable organization shall order, perform, enjoy and exercise the provisions of section 2.5 of the Finance and Revenue Law of the Republic of Liberia, of Section 20.6 of the Association Law of Liberia.

ARTICLE VI:

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V:

The corporation shall have a Board of Director, who subject to the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, shall hold office until their successors are duly qualified and elected and the initial members of Director, shall not be more than nine (9) person.
